There will be three judges from the sheep industry, and presentations will be judged using a rubric:

- -Voice 5
- -Stage Presence 10
- -Response to Questions 20

A winner will be chosen and all presentations will be recognized and placed. Prizes in the form of Amazon gift cards will be awarded.
