

MSPA YOUTH SCHOLARSHIPS

Due to the generosity of our members donating and buying items in our youth auction scholarships will be offered again this year. The scholarships will be awarded during the Shepherd's Weekend. Please review the guidelines below and encourage qualified candidates to apply.

Applicant requirements:

- Applicant may be full-time freshmen, sophomore, junior, or senior at a college, university, or technical school.
- Applicant may apply for the scholarship as many years as they meet the requirements but may only receive the scholarship once.
- Scholarship scoring:
 - 50 possible points on experience and involvement with the sheep industry
 - 25 possible points on academic record
 - 10 possible points on community service
 - 15 possible points on the essay
 - 25 bonus points if the applicant or their parent has been a member of MSPA for two years or more.

(In the case of a tie, it will be broken on the basis of a score for experience and involvement in the sheep industry.)
